Gunwharf Quays opened in February 2001 and is celebrating more than 25 years on Portsmouth's historic waterfront. Built on land shaped by centuries of naval history, through our ongoing investment it has become a central part of the city's visitor economy – as well as for guests nationwide – while retaining strong links to its maritime past.

The retail-led destination offers more than 90 brands alongside unique leisure and dining experiences, and is synonymous with the culture of Portsmouth. With a multi-million pound investment already in motion, we're transforming key areas of the outlet and reimagining spaces designed to elevate the guest experience well into the future.

We want local people to benefit from the opportunities created at Gunwharf Quays. Through our [Landsec Futures](#) social mobility programme and partnerships with organisations such as Ahead Partnership and Pompey in the Community, we support people into employment through training, mentoring and property-focused programmes.

As well as these partnerships, we're providing a financial bursary to one of the students studying property development at University of Portsmouth. Our centre management team also provides mentoring and tours for students to support their studies.

Environmental performance remains a priority, with investment in energy and carbon reduction initiatives delivering a 30% reduction in energy intensity since 2019, alongside continued exploration of renewable energy solutions.



SINCE 2019, GUNWHARF QUAYS HAS GENERATED £1.5 MILLION IN SOCIAL VALUE AND SUPPORTED 618 PEOPLE THROUGH EMPLOYABILITY PROGRAMMES.
