Located in the heart of Cardiff and comprising one-third of the city centre, St David's is one of the largest shopping destinations in the UK and offers 180 shops to its millions of visitors. When St David's opened in October 2009, it transformed Cardiff's city centre and helped establish the Welsh capital as one of the UK's leading retail destinations. More than fifteen years on, we continue to invest in its future, building on a legacy of developments that have reshaped the city.

In 2025, planning permission was secured from Cardiff City Council to transform a former Debenhams unit into a dynamic 102,000 sq ft city square. The redevelopment, designed in collaboration with more than 5,000 local residents, will provide high-quality leisure experiences, green spaces, and family-friendly environments.

Through our Landsec Futures social mobility programme and partnerships with organisations such as SAFE Foundation and Spear South Wales, we support people into employment through training, practical experience, and access to new opportunities. We also provide space within the centre free of charge for local charities.

Energy and sustainability initiatives have delivered a 7% reduction in energy intensity since 2019, alongside ongoing improvements in environmental performance.
