For more than 80 years, Landsec has been investing in the West End and at scale in Victoria. The transformation of Victoria began in 2005 with the redevelopment of 16 Palace Street and our headquarters in 80–100 Victoria Street. Public realm improvements such as the transformation of Cardinal Place, and our development of the Zig Zag building, 62 Buckingham Gate, Nova and n2 workplaces, have helped transform the area into one of London's most significant places for business, retail, and leisure.

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Over in the heart of the West End, Piccadilly Lights has been part of the Landsec story since 1968, and continues to bring millions of people together as the nation's noticeboard, iconic landmark, and destination of choice for global brand advertising.

Today, our West End portfolio is ingrained the fabric of the capital. Bringing together best-in-class workplaces, retail-led experiences, and green public spaces. We support the businesses and brands that drive forward London's success.

In 2025, our West End portfolio supported more than 23,000 jobs and contributed £3.8 billion to the UK economy. Because we're growing as a business, we're able to continue investing in our places and creating opportunities for people to access employment, develop skills, and build careers in real estate and beyond.
